### **South African Caffee**

We are a small shop selling only South African products like groceries, sweets, liquor, curios etc.

We sell our cigarettes at \$12.50 per box of 20 cigarettes which is very expensive compared to the \$9 – \$10 for 30 in New Zealand. Our cigarettes [are] mostly bought as a special treat or gift and not for everyday smoking.

The weight per box of 20 cigarettes is between 24g and 26g.

As you will see on the next page in our tables, it is all well-known international brands. The total value of the cigarettes imported was NZ\$13,907.66.
